

South Trenton Hurricane Irene Assistance Fund
Eligibility Criteria for Relocation Assistance

- 1). Funds would be donated to families left homeless and forced to relocate to a new home as a direct result of Irene and who lived in the South Trenton area of Ferry Street (area limits: Ferry St, to Bridge St. to Lambertson St. to Federal St. to S. Warren St. and everything in between). That means that families who are temporarily relocated, but eventually return to their home, would not be eligible.
- 2). Funds would be disbursed for security deposit and rent assistance only. Applicants need to show a lease or rent receipt or other proof of residence in their former location, and a lease for the new home. The amount of assistance will depend on how much funding we are able to raise, but it is unlikely that we will be able to cover the entire amount of the rent or security deposit. Therefore, applicants should seek additional assistance or have enough funds of their own to complete the necessary payments.
- 3). Disbursement would be made by check to the new landlord. Family income should not exceed 2 times the federal poverty guidelines for Mercer County. Paychecks, tax returns or employer letter need to be provided.
- 4). The head of household should be the applicant. One application per household. Families should fill out paperwork and request assistance showing the documentation stated above at Christ Episcopal Church, 331 Hamilton Ave. in Trenton, any Wednesday, from 5-7 PM, starting 9/7 (entrance through back of church). No appointment is necessary.
