**WHAT YOU NEED TO PROVE IDENTITY**

**ONE (1) of the following;**

**Two (2) of the following:**

Passport (any country)  
U.S. Driver license (NJ or other state)  
Consular ID Card  
NJ or Mercer County photo ID  
Permanent Resident card (Green Card)  
U.S. Work Authorization Card

Birth certificate (any country)  
Drivers license from country of origin  
Gov't or Voter's ID card (any country)  
Bank or school photo ID  
Social Security Card  
Letter from a sponsoring organization  
Library Card

**WHAT YOU NEED TO PROVE YOUR DOMICILE**

Electric bill, phone bill, mortgage statement, (no cell phone bill)  
Bank or financial account statement  
Copy of a lease or tax bill  
Any other bill or official letter addressed to your name and address

*This card is issued by the Tremendously Trenton and One Community coalitions, and is not an official government ID, but is endorsed by the City of Trenton, Ewing, Plainsboro, Princeton Borough, Princeton Township, , and West Windsor Police Departments, and the Mercer County Sheriff and Prosecutor's Office.
